
Asia Pacific International City Conference Agreement

Article 1: General Provisions

Article 1 (Name)

This Conference shall be called Asia Pacific International City Conference (abbreviation: APICC).

Article 2 (Purpose)

The purpose of the Conference is, overcoming the boundaries between participating LOM's, to deepen mutual understanding through serious discussion among youth businesspeople slated to become leaders of next generation about matters which are hard to discuss in a straightforward manner, including post-war issues, economic challenges and environmental security, and to develop and execute effective proposals which contribute to the development of Asia.

Article 3 (Contents of Business)

To achieve the purpose of the Conference, activities including the following are implemented. Also as a general rule, APICC General Conference is held annually.

1. Information exchange concerning the themes common to different countries
2. Visits to different countries and participation in projects to cultivate mutual insights
3. Presentations and Q&A sessions on common themes
4. Planning/implementation of joint projects

5. Other activities required to achieve the Purpose of the Conference

Article 2: Member LOM

Article 4 (Qualification)

As a general rule, Member LOM should be a LOM located in the capital city of the JCI member country or founding LOM in the country.

Article 5 (Registration)

LOM who wishes to join is required to meet Article 4 of this Agreement and is also required to participate in APICC as observer for two consecutive years. Upon completion of the two years of participation as observer, with the two-thirds consent of APICC member LOM's, the LOM is approved as a new member.

Article 6 (Rights)

Member LOM's have a right to participate in all activities and events related to the Conference. Each member LOM is given a right to cast one vote at APICC.

Article 7 (Obligations)

As a general rule, Member LOM's are required to join the activities held by the Conference and to proactively cooperate with the organizing LOM.

Article 3: Chairman LOM

Article 8 (Chairman LOM)

Chairman LOM of the Conference should be the capital city LOM of the ASPAC host country. If there is no APICC member LOM in the ASPAC host country, the Chairman LOM is determined upon coordination among member LOM's at the APICC of the previous year.

Article 9 (Role of Chairman LOM)

As a general rule, Chairman LOM of the Conference shall carry out the planning and organizing of APICC during the same period as when ASPAC is held. Chairman LOM shall develop and plan APICC agenda and local activities.

Article 4: Resignation

Article 10 (Resignation)

Member LOM who wishes to resign shall submit a written reason for resignation to APICC Chairman LOM of that year, and shall resign upon approval by two-thirds consent of the participating LOM's at the APICC of the said year.

Supplementary Provision:

This Agreement shall be effective as of November 2015.
